Subject: Racine Is Looking for a Bank Robber

The Racine Police Department is asking for assistance from the community in an attempt to locate a dangerous person currently wanted for Bank Robbery. We are looking for Adam L Locke of Racine. He is described as:

Male Black
Date of Birth: 01-12-81
Height/Weight: 6', 200#
Black Hair, Brown Eyes

As a result of the investigation into the Southern Lakes Credit Union robbery on 11-21-09, Locke has been positively identified as the offender and up to this point, has eluded both local and federal agencies looking for him. His criminal history includes:

Attempted 1st Degree Homicide
1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety
Possession of a Firearm by a Felon
Robbery by use of a Firearm
Drug related violations

In addition to the Criminal Warrant from our department for the credit union robbery with a bond of \$500,000, he is also wanted on a Bench Warrant from the Racine County Sheriffs' Department for Possession, Manufacturing, and Delivery of THC (Marijuana). The drug charges are body only and have no bond option.

We would like to remind the public, that there are criminal charges that can be filed against those that aid someone that has committed a felony. It is important that Adam Locke is located before he has another opportunity to commit further crimes in the community.

There is a photo of Adam Locke also available that will be sent in an attachment.

Should anyone see Adam Locke, they should not approach him, but make every effort to contact local police and provide as much detail as possible including clothing description, as well as location he is at, and the type of vehicle he may be in.
