UPDATE

Subject: HOMICIDE - 3315 Victory Avenue

After consulting with investigators who have completed initial interviews, additional information has surfaced. The masked offenders did enter via the front door of the home, and as a result of that noise, they woke up the mother of the victim who had been sleeping on the couch. As she spotted the masked offenders, she screamed and her son (the victim) came running down the stairs from the second floor, spotted the offenders, and attempted to return back up the stairs.

One of the offenders pursued the victim, dragging him back down to the living room and made the demands for “the money”. They then dragged the victim into the kitchen and a few minutes later, returned him to the living room where they threw him down onto a couch. One of the offenders headed for the door, while the other offender shot the victim several times in the upper body and face. The second offender then followed the first offender out of the area.

On today’s date at 1:01AM officers responded to the address of 3315 Victory Avenue for the report of an attempted homicide. Upon arrival, they spoke with a female occupant of the residence who advised officers that two masked parties had entered the home, ~~and entered the upstairs bedroom where she and her boyfriend were sleeping.~~

~~The masked men forcibly removed the boyfriend from the bedroom, taking him downstairs and shot him in the face several times. The masked men then fled the home in an unknown direction.~~ Racine Fire Department Rescue personnel attended to the victim but he was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The victim is a 28 year old male. Pending family notification, his identity is not being released. In addition to his girlfriend, there were two children in the home at the time of the home invasion. The children in the home are aged 4 and 8 years old. At this time, no suspects have been identified. Investigators are processing the scene in addition to interviewing family members that were in the home.

Based on the initial investigation, there is a belief that the victim in this case, was specifically targeted and may have known his attackers. This is not believed to be a random attack.
